**Background:** The Franklin Square UFSD has been awarded \$1,571,133 in Federal American Rescue Plan Act Funding to be utilized by 9/30/23

**Purpose:** The allocation has been awarded in the following subcategories:

- 90% LEA ARP-ESSER Allocation: \$871,133\*
  - 20% of this allocation (\$174,227) must be allocated to address learning loss
- 1% State-Level Reserve Comprehensive After School Grant \$100,002
- 1% State-Level Reserve Summer Enrichment Grant: \$100,002
- 5% State-Level Reserve for Learning Loss Grant: \$ 499,996

**Process:** In developing our plan, the District has held various discussions and sought input from stakeholders including the following:

Administrative Council Meetings, May 11, 2021 and May 24, 2021

Franklin Square Teachers' Association Meeting June 8, 2021

Board of Education Meeting June 8, 2021

Stakeholders involved included The Board of Education, Administrators, Teachers, Parents and Staff Members and Community Members.

**Plan:** The FSUFSD will utilize the ARP Allocations in the following ways:

- (i) The purchase of materials for classroom libraries.
- (ii) 2 FTE Social Workers.
- (iii) Morning Care Program Director.
- (iv) Multiple Consultants to assist us in enhancing our general and special education programs.
- (v) Sensory Materials for the Summer ISP Program.
- (vi) Educational based enhancements to the Summer Recreation Program.
- (vii) Nursing Services for the ACE Program.
- (viii) District-wide Phonics Program
- (ix) Math Lab Materials & Supplies

The District will utilize newly awarded Foundation Aid to fund these recurring expenditures listed above when the Federal Grants end.
