

POLK STREET SUMMER RECREATION—2017

Welcome to the **Polk Street School Summer Recreation Program!** Below you will find important information about the program. If you have any questions feel free to call the Summer Recreation Office at **481-4100 Ext. 3255** or come see me at any time.

1. **Time:** 9:00 am -12:00 pm - Monday-Thursday- **July 10-August 10**
2. **Program:** The children follow a pre-planned schedule. There are outside activities, gym activities, story time, game rooms, arts and crafts, drama class, computer class, special event days, and field trips. The children are divided into groups by grade. The Kindergarten through Grade 3 groups are a mix of boys and girls. In grades 4-7 the boys and girls are separated. Grades 4 and 5 are considered Juniors. Grades 6 and 7 are considered Seniors.
3. **Arrival to Summer Rec:** All children will enter through the main doors of Polk Street School and proceed directly to the gym. Each group should go to their meeting area and the head teacher will take attendance.
4. **Dismissal:**
 - **K-1:** They will be dismissed to an adult through the doors to the left of main doors. (**Door B**)
 - **2-3:** They will be dismissed to an adult through the main doors. (**Door A**)
 - **Juniors:** They will be dismissed to an adult through the doors to the right of main doors. (**Door G**)
 - **Seniors:** They will be dismissed through the low blacktop fence. If parents wish for a Senior to be dismissed without an adult, they must write a note stating so and give it to the head teacher.

**If someone other than a parent is picking your child up from summer rec, please write a note to the teacher.*
5. **Dress:** Children must wear sneakers and comfortable clothing. On designated Sprinkler Days, children must have a bathing suit, a towel, and sandals or water shoes. Sprinkler Days will be noted on the calendar.
6. **Snacks:** The children may bring in a healthy snack and a drink. No peanut products, candy, soda, or glass bottles please. Write your child's name on the snack bag. You are encouraged to send your child with a cold water bottle each day. **Children are not permitted to purchase snacks on field trips.**
7. **Field Trips:** Please see attached permission slips for your child's group. Please circle the trips that your child will be attending, sign, and return with payment in an envelope with your child's name and group on it. There is a **CASH ONLY** flat fee for all trips and in school activities. If your child does not attend a trip, the \$ will be used for various activities/special events during the summer. Please contact Coach with any individual concerns about reimbursement.
8. **Nurse:** The number to the nurse's office is 481-4100 **Ext. 3255**. Please contact the nurse if you have any concerns about allergies or other special medical needs.
9. **Cell Phones:** Cell Phones/Picture Taking/ Social Media Postings are not permitted during Summer Rec. Students may keep their cell phones in a bag and use them to contact parents after dismissal. If a student needs to contact a parent during Summer Rec, they must use the phone in the Summer Rec office.
