

## JOHN STREET SUMMER RECREATION

Welcome to the John Street School Summer Recreation Program. Listed below are some key aspects of the program that parents and children should be familiar with. If you have any questions about the program, stop in and see me in the Summer Recreation office at any time.

1. Time: 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. - July 10<sup>th</sup> to August 10<sup>th</sup> (Monday through Thursday)
2. Field Trip: A letter will be sent home on the first day of Summer Rec with information about trips, money and permission slips.
3. Arrival: All students will enter the building through the Cafeteria doors at 9:00. K/1/2 students will be escorted to their assigned classrooms by Teacher Aides. Jr. and Sr. students will line up in the gym in assigned spots.
4. Dismissal: Kindergarten, First, and Second Graders will be dismissed from their classrooms. Each child will be released directly to their parent. Please be waiting a few minutes prior to 12:00. Jr. and Sr. (Grades 3 - 6) will be dismissed through the Cafeteria doors. **Please stand in front of the cones for safety reasons.**
5. Dress: Children must wear sneakers and comfortable clothing. On Sprinkler Day, children must have a bathing suit, towel, and flip flops or water shoes. Sprinkler Day will be on Mondays and Wednesdays and the **last day of Summer Rec (August 10)**
6. Snacks: The children may bring in a healthy snack and a drink. Please no candy, soda, or glass bottles and please write your child's name on their snack bag. **Allergies will be taken into consideration.**
7. Program: Children follow a pre-planned schedule. There are outside activities, gym activities, story time, two game rooms, Arts and Crafts, drama class, computer class, special event days, and field trips to nearby attractions.
8. Early Pickup: Please come to the Summer Recreation office to pick up your child prior to 12:00. You will be asked to sign out your child. A note is needed from the parent if someone else is picking up a child at any time during or at the conclusion of the day.
