

WASHINGTON STREET SUMMER RECREATION--2017

Welcome to the Washington Street School Summer Recreation Program! Below you will find important information about the program. If you have any questions feel free to call the Summer Recreation Office at **481-4100 Ext. 3376** or come see me at any time.

1. **Time:** 9:00 am -12:00 pm - Monday-Thursday- **July 10-August 10**
2. **Program:** The children follow a pre-planned schedule. There are outside activities, gym activities, story time, game rooms, arts and crafts, drama class, computer class, special event days, and field trips. (Information on field trips and special days to follow.)
The children are divided into groups by grade. The Kindergarten through Grade 3 groups are a mix of boys and girls. In grades 4-7 the boys and girls are separated. Grades 4 and 5 are considered Juniors. Grades 6 and 7 are considered Seniors.
3. **Arrival on July 10 and 11 ONLY:**
 - **All Students (July 10 and July 11 ONLY)** The students will line up outside the Multi Purpose Room doors by cones according to grade level. If it rains on either of those days, we will follow the procedure for the remainder of the program explained below.
4. **Arrival for the remainder of the program:**
 - **K (For the remainder of the program)** The students will enter through the Multi Purpose Room doors and meet in the Multi Purpose Room.
 - **K-1-2-3 (For the remainder of the program)** The students will enter through the Multi Purpose Room doors and meet in the front of the gym.
 - **Juniors and Seniors (For the remainder of the program)** The students will enter through the main doors and meet in the back of the gym.
5. **Dismissal:**
 - **K-1:** They will be dismissed to an adult through the Multi-Purpose Room doors.
 - **2-3-Juniors:** They will be dismissed to an adult through the main doors.
 - **Seniors:** They will be dismissed through the Poppy Avenue doors.
6. **Dress:** Children must wear sneakers and comfortable clothing. On Sprinkler Days, children must have a bathing suit, a towel, and sandals or water shoes. Sprinkler Days will be on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
7. **Snacks:** The children may bring in a healthy snack and a drink. No peanut products, candy, soda, or glass bottles please. Write your child's name on the snack bag. You are encouraged to send your child with a cold water bottle each day. Children are not permitted to purchase snacks on field trips.
