Dear Parents:

First grade is always full of wonder and excitement for you and your child. Students will learn to read and write stories, develop basic math concepts (such as adding and subtracting), establish a curiosity and understanding for the world in which they live and much, much more.

Your child will need the following supplies with him/her on the **first day of school**.

- 2 Black dry erase markers
- 3 Dozen **sharpened** No. 2 pencils with erasers (standard yellow color and size)
- 3 Boxes of 24 crayons (including primary colors)
- 1 Pair of all metal blunt scissors (recommend Fiskars)
- 2 Large pink erasers
- 8 **LARGE** glue sticks
- 4 Hard-covered notebooks (string bound) (**NO SPIRALS!**)
- 3 Plastic folders with **BOTTOM** pockets (**NO SIDE POCKETS!**)
- 2 Large boxes of tissues (200 count)
- 2 **Large, soft** pencil cases, to fit pencils and crayons (**no hard cases/boxes**)
- 1 Small pencil sharpener with cover
- 1 Container Clorox wipes
- 1 4oz or larger of hand sanitizer antibacterial gel

Please send in the following supplies **by Friday of the first week**.

- 1 Set of broad tip, non-toxic markers, including primary colors
- 1 1-inch binder
- 1 Box of gallon size **Ziploc** bags and 1 box of sandwich size **Ziploc** bags
- 1 Old, large shirt or smock with your child's name labeled on it for the Art Room
- 1 Elmer's glue
- 2 Large packages of baby wipes (**unscented**)
- 1 Pair of inexpensive headphones (**NO EAR BUDS**)

## PLEASE LABEL ALL ITEMS

Your child's lunch money should be brought to school in a purse or envelope, **labeled** with his or her name. Additionally, a **healthy snack should be brought each day beginning on the first day of school**.

It is important that all supplies are **labeled** with your child's name and class.

**Also, please put your child's name in his/her jacket and lunch box.**
